Service Time and Station: 9:30am — 87.9 FM

Arrival and Departure: Ushers will be working to arrange cars for a proper distance and placement. They will also be dismissing the parking lot after the service. Please plan to arrive at least 10-15 minutes early so that the service can begin on time and be patient in being dismissed.

Remaining in Our Vehicles: We understand the deep desire to see each other again, and we will get there eventually, but for now we ***require everyone to remain in their vehicles at all times while on church grounds until further notice*** (the upstairs restroom at the church will be open for emergencies).
